1. <b>Winners' Lounge</b>	The winning pieces of APFW 2019 Creative Contests (photo, artistic poster, and video) and a poster of the Champion of the Asia-Pacific Forests will be exhibited.
2. <b>Eco-Market Place</b>	Small-scale producers will showcase and sell their products made using forest resources.
3. <b>Forest Fashion</b>	Clothes and textiles made from forest materials will be displayed.
4. <b>Forest Spa</b>	Health & beauty products from the forests will be exhibited.
5. <b>VR Zone</b>	Virtual Reality facility for people to experience a stroll inside 4-5 Korean recreational forests
6. <b>Woodcraft Zone</b>	Zone for people to make handmade crafts like pencil case and bookshelf
7. <b>Photograph Zone</b>	Decorated to provide people an indirect forest experience

<b>Wild Bar Tea Time</b>	Forest-based tea, coffee and other beverages will be offered during selected morning and afternoon breaks (10:00-10:30, 15:00-15:30) on 18, 19, 21 June.
<b>Wild Bar Happy Hour</b>	Wine & liquor from different countries will be offered before dinner (5-6 pm) on 17, 18 and 19 June
<b>Slow Food</b>	Sampling of slow food using forest-based ingredients to spur discussions on food systems and agricultural policies as they relate to SFM
<b>Green Drinks Songdo</b>	Opportunity for networking with companies and civil society groups on environmental concerns & initiatives after office hours on 20 June at a nearby bar
<b>Eco-friendly Market Lightning Session</b>	Quick and energetic presentations on eco-friendly forest products from the APFW participants
